
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# ENHANCING HOW YOU LIVE IN YOUR HOME

## ROOM-BY-ROOM TRANSFORMATIONS

#### KITCHEN

Often considered the 'heart' of the home due to the whole family congregating there, the kitchen sets the style of your house. Improving the flow and maximising bench space for meal prep, organising and entertaining are key to making this hub highly functional and appealing. Whether you are planning a completely new kitchen or modernising an existing one with cabinetry, tiles and tapware, we can help you find the best options for your goals and budget.







#### EXTRA LOUNGE AND MEDIA ROOMS

The lounge is where the family gathers to unwind after a busy day and entertain guests on the weekend. It's an area that needs to maximise comfort when reading, playing games and curling up on the couch to watch movies. To maximise practical space, consider a custom-made floor-to-ceiling storage wall that holds all your books to your television and even a pull-down desk for study. Space for a new family bathroom (saving the kids using the downstairs bathroom) and also this extra nook for the kids to watch TV and play games was achieved.






#### BEDROOMS

Need an extra room? If you have space to extend, this can be the perfect opportunity to create an ideal master bedroom, complete with an ensuite bathroom and walk-in wardrobe. If you're redesigning your existing space – particularly if yours is an old bungalow or villa with no cupboards – consider built-in storage such as window seats and wardrobes for much-needed storage.











#### LAUNDRY

It may be a dreaded chore, but an organised and functional laundry area can improve this tedious task tenfold. Ideally, the laundry should provide ample storage for all washing necessities and cleaning products, along with laundry baskets, an ironing board/steamer and the space to organise washing. Splashbacks up the style quotient and protect the wall from moisture.

#### BATHROOMS

As one of the busiest spaces in the home, the bathroom requires careful planning to maximise both space and functionality. First, consider the amount of storage you need. A key feature of this space, the vanity can be freestanding, wall hung, double or single, and likewise, the tapware can be vanity top mounted or wall mounted. A bathroom redesign is where we will discuss the best shower and/or bath arrangement for the space and whether you'd like the luxury of underfloor heating.




#### WISE WORDS

Fixtures and fittings can dramatically transform a home. Swapping run-of-the-mill silver tapware and handles in bathrooms and kitchens for a contemporary design or even a striking shade like black, bronze or gold can turn a space from ho-hum to appealing.



#### FLOORING

Flooring can set the tone of your home. There are many different flooring options available, and each has its pros and cons for different areas of the home. Hardwood / engineered wood has a luxurious underfoot feel, while hard-wearing laminate flooring is suited to those needing a minimal maintenance option that stands up to pets and kids. Tiles are ideal in wet areas such as bathrooms, while carpet adds warmth and texture to living areas and bedrooms.



#### WISE WORDS

Collate a digital (Pinterest or Instagram) or physical folder (magazines) of the home style and trends that appeal to you with notes on the colours, features and scale you like. Show it to your architect or designer to help realise your vision.



#### LIGHTING

Electrical lighting is a practical necessity (especially in old villas and bungalows, which usually just have a single bulk per room) and adds ambience and style. For optimal lighting and electrical options for your lifestyle, home, and budget, we can organise a professional plan from an electrician or free lighting designs from suppliers. Considerations include LED lights to reduce power bills, high-end automatic lights, bedside light switches that control main and side lights, as well as outdoor and security lighting. Bathroom lighting is also crucial to comfort and varying needs so you may want dimmable lights for candlelit baths and bright makeup lighting by the mirror.

#### PAINT

A fresh coat of paint can do wonders for a room, lightening dark spaces, helping to highlight features of the home and creating a unique style to suit your personality. Neutral colours are the least polarising when it comes to selling the property, but if you plan to enjoy your home for years to come, go ahead and stamp your style on the interior. 
### ENERGY EFFICIENCY / INSULATION / HEATING & COOLING / GAS FIREPLACES

An energy audit will fully inform you of the type of existing insulation, R-value, and depth or extent of the insulation, and you can decide if further installation is required.

Consider installing a ducted heat pump/air conditioning system to keep your home blissfully cool on scorching days and toasty in winter. Gas underflooring is another option that can heat and even cool the entire home, while an HRV system will ensure the air inside the home is clean. Retro double glazing is useful to reduce noise and increase the warmth of an old home. If you're an audiophile, you may like to instal a home audio system that ensures your favourite podcasts or tunes can be heard from whatever room you're in.

#### STORAGE

If you have a family, you can never have too many cupboards. It's worthwhile considering what your unique home storage needs are and where they are currently lacking to figure out a renovation that allows easy access to your things and optimal home organisation. With a little imagination, unused corners and alcoves can become pockets of useful storage space.








#### FITTINGS AND FIXTURES

Although choosing a tap may seem a simple task, don't underestimate the impact that fixtures and fittings can have on your overall aesthetic. We can advise you on different options for different budgets, so whether you're spending up on designer options or not, there will be something to suit your renovation. Having a vision board in the initial stages of your renovation process will be your guiding light in choosing the ideal fittings.



#### ENTRANCES

The entrance sets the initial tone for the home and its worth taking the time to plan. If you don't already have, then consider space for a bench seat and storage for shoes, coats and hats, or a hall table. Feature lighting can enhance an entrance and creates a welcoming ambience in the evening.



#### DECKS

Maximising your outdoor area can add to the enjoyment you get from your home. Adding decks off the bedrooms or facing the backyard ensures you can enjoy the fresh air and a view (if you're lucky enough to have one!) or have a secure place for young children and pets to roam free, as well as enjoy sunny weekends outdoors-at-home.



## THE INTERIOR DESIGN PROCESS

The design process should be divided into manageable stages. This gives time to make decisions along the way and ensures the result is as close to your vision as possible.

#### 1. Selecting your renovation company

Select your design professional to design your renovation and complete the plans and submit them to the council (if required). An experienced renovation company will usually have their own in-house architect or will work from plans supplied by an architectural designer of your choice. Using an in-house architect provides greater certainty that the plans will come within budget and makes it easier and faster to make any changes.

#### 2. Concept design

Great design should reflect your lifestyle, personality and how you want to feel when you are at home, so this stage is crucial to making sure that your renovation company understand exactly what you want from a home renovation. This is the stage to bring all your magazine cut-out pictures and Pinterest boards, and discuss your ideas, project scope and desired outcome with your design professional. It is also an opportunity to ask them for their suggestions. They will sketch your ideas and make sure they are buildable and within your budget. They will also be able to let you know if you require council consent for the project or if it is exempt. Experienced professionals can offer ways to save money and rejig the budget to other areas.


#### 3. Preliminary design

Your designer will organise the plans and specify the building products. At this stage, you will also need to know which materials, products, appliances and fittings you want to use to achieve your desired results and fit your budget. Your renovation company or designer can source these and make recommendations, and take you shopping in the trade showrooms if you are undecided.

#### 4. Working drawings engineering and consent (if required)

If consent is required for the works being completed once all products and design decisions are defined, the designer will fully detail the plans confirming all necessary construction details and specifications. Your renovation company will discuss whether an independent engineer needs to check building loads and bracing, etcetera, as well as whether any Council Building and Resource Consents are required or if the renovation qualifies as exempt work. An experienced renovation company typically organises the consents on your behalf.

## MONEY TALK: SETTING THE BUDGET



It's useful to have a budget in mind before beginning discussions with any potential contractors and suppliers. Naturally, your budget must align with how ambitious the renovation is and factor in the design elements, products, finishes, fittings and appliances. If you plan to enjoy your home for the foreseeable future, you may be prepared to invest more. If it's a short term home or investment property, you will want to spec the project for market.

Remember, it's easy for budgets to blow out and timeframes to go overboard when you're managing a renovation on your own. Allocation of the budget is important in the initial stages of the renovation. Most people will find that a fully managed project is easier to manage when broken down into a weekly payment schedule that aligns with the completed work each week.

#### **WORKING WITH YOU**

#### STEP 1: INITIAL MEETING

#### **Outcomes: Project outline**

We'll meet with you to get an overview of the project, understand your goals, and look at the property or the plans. During this early stage, we'll ask you to have a budget in mind so we know what we're working with. We'll work backwards and allocate to your goals as per the budget. It's helpful to bring in Pinterest boards of styles you like and ideas you'd like to incorporate into your home.

#### STEP 2: PRELIMINARY COSTING MEETING

#### Outcomes: Acceptance of project scope and preliminary budget

At this stage, we'll break down and allocate the budget further to see what's achievable from your goals. We also give approximate budget outlines for bathrooms, flooring and kitchens in this meeting. If you are happy with the initial cost estimates, we then refine it from there.

#### STEP 3: SELECTION MEETING

#### Outcomes: All materials selected and all trades quotes

We're now ready to get the tradespeople to put together the final costings. For time efficiency, we often bring in the tiler, floorer, plumber and painter all at once to give their quotes.

#### STEP 4: LET'S GO SHOPPING

Now for the fun bit – pulling it all together. We'll take you on shopping trips to trade showrooms. This is enjoyable and far less overwhelming with our help. You'll get the job done in an hour or two instead of spending multiple weekends driving across the city to visit different stores.

#### STEP 5: PRESENTATION OF PRELIMINARY DESIGN AND CONTRACT

#### Outcomes: Acceptance and works programmed

Once you've approved the design, read over the quote and contract and feel sure that it will tick all the boxes for you, it's time to get the ball rolling on your renovation. If your project requires council consent we will prepare the plans and organise consent.

#### STEP 6: IT'S GO TIME


